

BECAUSE I LOVE YOU CELLPHONE COVER


Something special for someone special, give a hug and a kiss to someone you love. This cell phone cover is knit in the round.

Approx 2 1/2 x 4 (can be adjusted to fit most cellphones)

- Gauge approx. 24 sts to 4"
- 3.75 mm dpns (set of 4) 5US
- 3.25 mm dpn (2) 3 US
- (1) ball Berrocco Comfort DK MC
- (1) ball Berrocco Comfort DK Variegated
- Darning needle, scissors, measuring tape, Button.

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Cast on 32st using **Long tail cast on** (divide stitches onto 3 needles)
 Knit 3 rows in main colour
 Begin design as charted.



Legend

- k (knit)
- darkgreen (dark green)

Repeat rows:1 to 8 (3 ½ times)

Knit 2 rows

Garter stitch for 3 rows

Cast off 17 stitches along the front edge.

Work remaining 15st in Garter stitch

Row 1: sl, k2tog, pss0, k12, sl, k2tog, pss0

Row 2: knit

Row 3: sl, k2tog, pss0, k2, yo, k2, sl, k2tog, pss0

Row 4: k3, kfb, k4 (kfb = knit into the front and back of same st)

Row 5: knit

Cast off and darn in ends to finish pouch.

Icord (optional)

With 3.25mm dpn (3US) pick up one side of the main colour line up the side of the pouch.

Cast on 3st, starting at the bottom of the pouch, work applied icord.
Knit 2st then k2tog. Return the 3st back to the left needle repeat this process till all the pouch stitches are used up.

At the top of the pouch, pick up an additional 2 stitches. (5st) continue to Icord to the desired length of the strap. K2tog, pss0 (3st)

Pick up the other side of the main colour line up the side of the pouch. Starting at the top of the pouch, work applied icord.

Knit 2st then k2tog. Return the 3st back to the left needle repeat this process till all the pouch stitches are used up.

Gather stitches on a needle and darn in end to finish.
